## 2010 ACU Youth Classes & Club Championship Rules

### 2010 Youth Classes

The age limits and capacity classes for 2010 are as follows:

\* Please refer to ACU handbook for full details

Class	From	To	i.e. you will be	Max Bike Size**
A	01/01/1993	31/12/1994	16 or 17 in 2010	125cc
B	01/01/1995	31/12/1997	13,14 or 15 in 2010	125cc
C	01/01/1998	31/12/2000	10,11 or 12 in 2010	80cc
D	01/01/2001	31/12/2003	*6,7,8 or 9 in 2010	50cc mono/80cc T/S/100W electric
E	01/01/2004	no limit	*must be at least 4	750W electric

\*Youth Riders **MUST** be at least 4 years of age to compete on an electric bike & 6 years for combustion engines.

\*\*Youth Riders **MUST** comply with the above bike size limits irrespective of the class they ride in.

#### NOTE:

Youth A class competitors wishing to ride easier routes will be included in a B+, C+ or D+ class

Youth B class competitors wishing to ride easier routes will be included in C+ or D+ classes

Youth C class competitors wishing to ride easier routes will be included in the D+ class

**ALL** riders **MUST** be a member of the Club and hold a current ACU trials registration card, which must be produced when signing-on.

### Club Championship Rules

Competitors must ride in at least **3** championship rounds to qualify.

Where a competitor switches class the results from the greatest number of rounds ridden in a class or highest finishing position will count, they will feature in only one class at the end of the year.

The best 5 results from 7 rounds will count in the Championship

*Should a round be cancelled the Club will try to organise a replacement. However, it reserves the right to reduce the number of rounds.*

In each round points are awarded for the various classes as follows:

1st - 20 points, 2nd - 17, 3rd - 15, 4th - 13, 5th - 11, 6th - 10, 7th - 9, etc down to 15th - 1 point

At the end of the year any tie-breaks are decided by the best scores in the final round.
